Save the Date! North American Agricultural Safety Summit, *Raising Safety 2020: Cultivating a Culture of Safety*, March 19-20, 2020, Las Vegas, NV. The summit will inspire and guide the improvement of safe work practices in agriculture while addressing emerging and challenging issues. Network with agricultural safety and agribusiness leaders; gain access to best practices and programs for agricultural workers. Hosted by the Agricultural Safety and Health Council of America (ASHCA). Discussions will include on-farm and process safety around equipment, livestock and dairy, row-crops, grain handling, food and specialty crops, individual and workforce safety, and other commercial agricultural production and business operational safety issues.
